Global Unnayan Seba Sangstha (GUSS) is a socio-economic development organization for non-profit, non-government and non-political organization working for human, social, economic and cultural development of the underprivileged people for the establishment of their basic rights in the society. GUSS effect developed by:

- Development technique and support provide to target people;
- Leadership development;
- Mobilize civil society as support forum and provide them development orientation for strengthen their role to participate in development Activities;
- Empowerment of poor women imparting formal and non-formal field-based training;
- Provide financial support for understanding different income generation activities;
- Empowering the local government institution and provide technical support/assistance to strengthen their role in village development;
- Provide need-based training to the workers of GUSS home and abroad for enhancing their knowledge & skill to perform their activities; Response for emergency support.

GUSS established in 2012 by a group of social development activist with a common interest to promote CBO (Community Based Organization) and poor peoples in action for poverty alleviation through empowering process in terms of awareness, organization, leadership and economy by forming a target group. Support forum and existing Union Parishad, Municipality imparting of training, workshop and undertaken income generation activities and conduct research to innovation ideas and publicize recent advance.

GUSS Capacity Building Activities:

- 1. Attending regular workshops in Govt. and private sectors development.
- 2. Arranging and participating skill development training Courses for regular and volunteer staff.

Description of Major Project Activities:

1. PROJECT TITLE: Tailoring and Computer training program at Durgapur, Rajshahi.

GUSS is implementing this project for the youth and widow for the improvement of their livelihood. A number of 300 participants are getting the training at present. After receiving the training they will be able to receive financial assistance under livelihood development program.

2. PROJECT TITLE: Health Care Project, Bhola, Barguna and Patuakhali Districts.

GUSS is implementing this project to provide support to the primary school students and the Madrasa going students in Bhola, Barguna and Patuakhali District. The students have been providing water bottles. The primary schools also have been getting support for water and sanitation facilities.

3. Project Title: Emergency humanitarian support for Burmese Rohingya.

GUSS is providing emergency support to the forcedly ousted Rohingya citizen from Myanmar. Under this project GUSS has distributed Food and non-food items. A total of 520 Rohingya families got shelter support and 200 families got WASH, Solar Light, and Bathing Place for their protection. About 3000 Rohingya children received clothing support as Eid gift and 1800 HHs got food pack for Eid festival in this period. Besides, at least 7,000 Rohingya families has received Food packages (Rice, Pulse, White, Sugar, Cooking oil, Infant food, Shelter materials (Cloths, Tents, Water Pot, Mosquito nets, Blankets, Solar panels etc.), WASH items (Medicines, Hygiene kits for adolescent girls, ORS, Water purification Tablets etc.).

National & International Days Observance:

The organization has participated rally, Seminar, Interactive Meeting Including Various Colorful programs.

We celebrated the World **Women Day** this year with our special attention. On the occasion of the day, we organized Discussion Meeting and other programs and recommended many steps for their further development.

World Population Day:

As part of the regular program, we arranged World Population Day 2019. This year we conducted Meeting, Rally and other programs. We also distributed concerned medicine and materials among the pregnant mothers.

This year we observed the National Youth Day. We organized many programs for the purpose. With the financial assistance of the Department of Youth Development we organized training program for poor people on Goat rearing.

This year we have participated the rally and celebrated the historic 7th March speech recognized as world heritage by UNSCO. This program was organized by the Govt. of Bangladesh and NGO affairs Bureau has conducted the rally in 2019.

GUSS has a general body 21 members and Executive body 07 members elected the executive body for 2 years. Chairman is the Head of the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee has approved the General Secretary to perform as CEO. He is overall responsible for any programme or project run by GUSS. GUSS is the highest policy formulation body and meets two times in a year to review and approve plans, budget s, expenditures and program and also formulate policy decision and meets quarterly to approve and review the quarterly plans, budgets, expenditures and program makes policy decisions. It has strong advisory council of three member that play role in policy making and other necessary decisions.
